Doug/Kirk made a motion to allow the Eagles use of our field on our terms until their new field is setup. Todd will meet with the Eagle's president to discuss sharing the field and field maintenance costs. Ed made a motion to create a committee to make guidelines for shared use of the field.

Our radio impound box might be too small for additional radios. If we purchase the shed, we need to allocate part of this for a bigger radio impound box. Kirk/Doug made a motion to buy the shed for \$600.

The bulk fuel purchases was brought up.

The Port Huron Tree Toppers are looking for new members. They are charging \$10 (dues and initiation fee total).

Sheila/Gary made the motion to close the meeting at 7:22 PM.
