Meeting started at 6:08 pm. Secretary's and Treasurer's reports were read and accepted.

The progress being made with the Lease was discussed. The park wants a yearly lease renewal and \$500 yearly rent. We also have to move the shed back onto Propbusters land.

It was brought up that the club should become more involved in the meetings held by the park boards so we can have more say on what happens to our field. Sum members volunteered to attend various meetings.

Mike Grant has received reservations for half of the tables available for the swap. We have one more meeting before the swap.

We discussed the tractor repair. Todd is checking to see if his dad can repair it. A repair manual for the woods would be helpful if one can be located.

A motion was made to have one vote for all nominated club officers, as there was only one candidate for each office. Gary Smedes was elected President. Doug McLaren was re-elected as Vice-President. Ed Olszewski was re-elected as Treasurer. Keith Graham was re-elected as Secretary.

Mike Grant is remaining as the Safety Officer. The Safety Officer shall oversee AMA and Propbusters' safety rules and enforcement.

Ray Dart was appointed as Field Marshall. The Field Marshall shall oversee AMA rules and regulations and Propbusters' regulations for field layout and enforcement.

There was a mistake in the Dec. newsletter about the AMA Intro Pilots. Jack DeLisle, Greg Feyers and Todd Litke are the club's Intro Pilots.

New members William Lawson, Grant Partridge, and Robert Troy were voted into the membership. We had a number of members renew membership during the meeting. The website now reflects the 2005 membership. At the end of the meeting, 16 members haven't renewed (4 Junior, 1 Senior, and 11 Regular).

Stan brought up the need for the President to elect 3 directors to assist him as stated in the bylaws. The Directors shall monitor the club's fiscal activities to abide by the rules for a non-profit organization. Since Gary's term in office won't start until the Jan. meeting, this issue is tables.

A motion was made and passed to spend up to \$200 to install a second drain across the field. The drain will be installed the Friday after the meeting.

The club voted to begin looking for a new field.

Sheila/Doug voted to end the meeting at 8:15 pm.
