The meeting was held at the field starting at 6:05. Present were 13 Propbusters and 3 Redline Racers.

The 4H Fair Flying Demonstration was rehashed.

The Web Site was brought up. We need to print out the address for the sign at the field.

Advertising and supplies for the Toys For Tots was discussed. I will contact the Times Herald and Channel 6. I also added a flyer to the newsletter for distribution. Rob will pick up the concession stuff and Gary will bring out the grill.

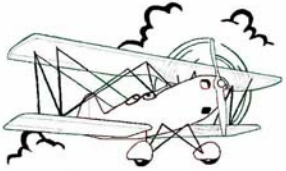
